In English we will be learning.....

- whilst reading books including Man on the Moon, The Dark and Traction man.
- to use Questions and commands and the difference between them
- to use more 2A and list sentences
- to use lots of different conjunctions including because, but, or, yet, so, when
- to write using exclamations with the correct punctuation.
- to join our handwriting consistently.
- to use our phonics to spell more complex words.

In History we will be learning....

- about significant individuals in Space including Neil Armstrong and Tim Peake.
- about the events in the space race and how they contributed to the landing on the moon.
- to compare how news is delivered in 1969 and 2015.
- to think about what was left on the moon, what it tells us about this time and whether it was right or not.

In PSHE we will be learning...

- about our emotions and how to manage them.
- about managing change.

In PE we will be learning.....

- about points of contact in Gymnastics
- about linking movements in dance.
- about teamwork in OAA.
- about running, throwing, catching and rolling in games.

In Computing we will be learning...

- how to be safe when using technology
- how to create our own video or ebook.

In Music we will be learning....

- about pulse and rhythm
- to compose music using glockenspiels

In Maths we will be learning.....

- about numbers to 100, their place value and what each digit means.
- about counting in 2's, 5's, 10's and 3's
- comparing numbers within 100.
- our number bonds to 20 and number bonds to 100.
- how to add and subtract 2 digit numbers.
- how to add, subtract and compare money to find totals and change needed.
- how to make equal groups and use arrays.
- to learn our 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

In Science we will be learning....

- to distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made.
- to identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock
- to describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials
- to compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties.
- to use our knowledge of materials to make moon houses.

In Art/DT we will be learning...

- about different painting techniques, Van Gogh and Gaston de la Touche.
- how to create different patterns and textures using clay.
- how to join materials together, design and evaluate model moon houses.

In RE we will be learning...

- about what Christians believe God is like.
- about why Christmas matters to Christians.
