

In **ART** we will be exploring 3 dimensions in sketching and sculpture, using Ancient Greek pottery and sculpture as inspiration.


In **MATHS** we will be continuing to develop arithmetic and mental calculation skills, whilst also learning about 2D and 3D shape, and measurements including volume, length and mass. We will be thinking about how to use what we already know to solve a range of problems.

In **DT** we will be designing, making and evaluating our own Ancient Grecian vases, as well as exploring the effects created by a range of stitches.

In **Computing** we will continue to use Google Classroom to support our learning, as well as learning to use coding to create a simple maze game, and using digital technology to support our music learning.

In **MFL** we will be continuing to learn French; looking at French food and shopping, as well as the French alphabet and pronunciation.

In **SCIENCE** we will be using a range of enquiry skills as we investigate what we know about space; looking at the planets, and how the Earth, Sun and moon move in relation to each other and the impact that has on our lives.

*One class's journey into the stars*

Summer Term Topic Web

This term Hercules will be stepping beyond their comfort zone to explore, discover and learn as much as they can about the world beyond what we can see ourselves ... journeying into space and beyond! We will also be considering how the Ancient Greeks viewed the same stars!

In **HISTORY** we will be considering how the Ancient Greeks studied the stars and investigated space, as well as looking at how they lived and the impact they have had on lives, through looking at their art and architecture.

In **GEOGRAPHY** we will be looking at the significant human and physical aspects of modern Greece and considering what it tells us about Ancient Greece.

In **PSHCE** we will be looking at our own approaches to learning, as well as looking at managing change, and sex and relationship education.

In **LITERACY** we will be using the book *'The Girl of Ink and Stars'* to learn about Myths and to inspire our own narrative writing, whilst continuing to learn how our use of different sentence types, punctuation, vocabulary and grammar has an impact on our writing. We will also be developing our comprehension skills, ensuring that we pick out clues that the writer has left for us, to understand the deeper meaning within a text.

In **MUSIC** we will be discovering how to compose our own music, using both traditional instruments and electronic sounds with an iPad APP. We will also be exploring how music can be used to tell a story whilst looking at 'The Firebird' by Stravinsky.

In **PE** we will be exploring and developing our striking and fielding skills whilst playing Rounders, and thinking about our fitness whilst undertaking astronaut style training exercises. We will also be learning a traditional Greek dance and creating our own mini Olympics.

In **RE** we will be continuing to find out more about Humanism, Salvation and Incarnation.
